

# REC CAMP REMINDERS

Thank you for choosing Seymour's Summer Recreation Camp for your child's summer camp experience! We are looking forward to another exciting summer filled with laughs, games, field trips, and much more! Most of your questions can be answered by reading the handbook on line. Below are some reminders.



## CAMP SCHEDULE

This year, we are offering 3 – two week sessions from June 23 – August 1. The camp day is Monday – Friday, 8:30 am – 2:30 pm at Seymour High School. There will be no Camp on July 4.

## SELF-ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICATION FORMS

If your child is going to self-administer medication during camp such as an epi-pen or inhaler, we must receive the completed Self-Administration of Medication Form (on website) no later than June 2. We do not have a nurse on staff.

## LUNCH DAYS + ICE CREAM FRIDAYS

Two lunch days are included in the camp price. Wednesdays (Hot Dog or Burger and fries) & Fridays (Pizza & Ice Cream). Campers must bring a bagged lunch on the other days.



# DROP-OFF/PICK-UP AT SHS (DROP OFF PROCEDURE TBD)

Camp is at Seymour High School this year. The drop off procedure will be sent to you in June. Drop-off will start every morning promptly at 8:30 am. Pick-up will begin at 2:00 pm and run to 2:30 pm. We ask that you remain in your car for both Drop-off and Pick-Up. A Counselor will open the car door and direct your child to their assigned group. A late fee of \$30 will be assessed after 2:30 pm for pick up. Please do not arrive for morning drop off before 8:20 am or pick up before 1:50 pm.

#### CAR TAGS

We mail 2 car tags to each family in June. The car tags help counselors recognize your vehicle as a safe car.

## TOP SECTION

 Hang this section from your car mirror to help make pick up quick and safe. If your car does not have a car tag you must pull forward and wait to be assisted by a staff member.

# BOTTOM SECTION

• Is a wallet card that contains the camp phone number. Keep this card with you.

#### SWIM

Swim days at Seymour High will take place Mondays (Grades K–2), Wednesdays (all grades), & Fridays (Grades 3–5). Please make sure that your child comes prepared with a bathing suit & towel. Your child must be able to swim independently to attend swimming. Floatation Devices are not allowed.
