General Statement of Duties:

The Arts & Crafts Instructor is responsible for the day –to-day instruction and oversight of arts and crafts at our camp. The Instructor will develop integrated daily art projects that will stimulate creativity of 1st-8th graders.

- Assist as needed in dismissal of campers at conclusion of day
- Assist as need on field trip days.
- Carry out other duties as deemed necessary by Recreation Director to assure success of camp
 including but not limited to coverage of an assigned group in the absence of a counselor and
 attendance at all field trips if requested

- Experience in arts & crafts instruction or a desire to pursue
- The desire and ability to work in a cooperative, team-oriented atmosphere
- Enthusiasm, an abundance of energy, sense of humor, patience and self-control are essential
- Must be available to work Mon Fri for 7 continuous weeks 8:15am-2:45pm
- Must work flexible hours before the start of camp to ensure projects and calendar are developed
- Must pass CPR/First Aid Courses, concussion training, blood borne pathogen training and a background check (18 years of age or older) as required by the Seymour Recreation Department
