

The state legislature has voted the Medicare Savings Program for the state of Connecticut (with no change in income limits) back into law.

Even though this was vetoed by the Governor, the legislature was successful in overriding his veto. This means that the program is now back in law, unchanged, for this budget year. I am sure it will be part of discussions in the next budget year, but for now, it will continue.


Seymour High School pool is open for swimming, exercise and fun on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday evenings. Adult lap lanes are available. Registration required.
